Company Profile

Wilberforce College is a sixth-form college in Hull with approximately 1,000 full-time students taking a range of courses. It is a diverse and dynamic educational system and the first choice for students after Year 11 in East Yorkshire.

Business Needs

The college has a high number of pupils, 120 staff and a number of educational facilities. The College was looking to improve their Health & Safety training and risk assessments for all their staff, across DSE, Manual Handling and Fire Safety. These classroom training activities were proving to be a time consuming activity for the Health and Safety Manager, especially when retraining and new starts were taken into account.
