You have a duty of care which exists every time an employee uses a vehicle (including their own) for business related travel. Approximately 20 people are killed and a further 250 seriously injured weekly, due to work related driving accidents.

The Corporate Manslaughter Legislation that came into effect on the 6th of April is especially relevant to this area.
